HEADLINE: Speculative juniors offer higher risks and rewards

The junior end of the resources sector is filled with speculative stocks, that may go nowhere or skyrocket. They are rare, but when low-priced stocks jump, they offer big profits for relatively small investment. Some stocks worth a punt are Breakaway Resources, a West Australian junior nickel explorer led by former LionOre Mining exploration manager, Peter Buck, and Gunson Resources, which has a speculative copper project in the same region as BHP Billiton's Olympic Dam. Bass Metals is exploring Tasmania for base metals in the same area as Zinifex has its Rosebery operation. Gryphon Minerals is chasing gold in the African country of Burkina Faso, while Pioneer Nickel is doing the same much closer to home, in the Goldfields region of Western Australia. Ausquest, formed by ex-Rio Tinto employees, has a host of exploration projects in the boil. Minotaur Exploration discovered copper and gold and Prominent Hill, now being developed by Oxiana. Minotaur is also investing in other companies, such as uranium miner Toro Energy. Legend Mining has sold its gold mine, and is now concentrating on a copper and nickel discovery at Gidgee. Lastly, Navigator Resources has a promising 70,000 ounce gold resource at Leonora in WA.
