

# Mining Briefs: Bass improves graphite recovery

**Bass Metals** has improved the rate of recovery from Loharano mine feedstock from 47% to 59% through its operational optimisation program at the Graphmada graphite mine in eastern Madagascar.

The company said the improved rate of recovery had proved to be stable, without any loss in the average final product grade, while grades after the primary re-grind mill also improved, from an average of 61% fixed carbon to an average of 69%.

Bass chief executive Tim McManus said these improvements had come only eight weeks after the company had taken control of the asset from StratMin Global Resources.

Activities including processing plant testwork, workshop construction and a JORC resource update for Loharano were all underway, the company added.
